Monopoly Walk Option 1: The Apple Walk

Distance: 3.36km (2miles)

Start: Park Road



From Park Road, cross over the road into the Recreation Ground, take the path that runs alongside the tennis courts. At the end of this path you will find a footbridge that takes you over the railway lines.

Cross the long bridge, and take the final set of steps down into, Bramley Avenue. Keeping left to stay on Bramley Avenue, until you reach Worcester Close, a turning on your right.

Worcester Close

Walk through the cul-de-sac that is Worcester Close, to the other side and wander along the cut-through into Laxton Way. Turn left and walk up until you see another cut-through on you right, this leads to the A2.

Faversham Town FC

Turn right and walk down until you see Salters Lane on the opposite side of the road, where the Club has its grounds.

To continue with the circular walk, turn left and walk to...

Love Lane

Love Lane is one of the major routes into Faversham. Continue the full length of Love Lane. You will go past Faversham Cemetery which was built in 1898. Within the Cemetery







there are 64 graves dedicated to Faversham's service men who fell during WW1 and WW2. There is also a mass grave and memorial dedicated to the 108 people killed in the gunpowder explosion of 1916.

Once past the Cemetery, turn left over the railway bridge to reach Whitstable Road. Head towards town to pick up the circular walk again at Millfield Road.
